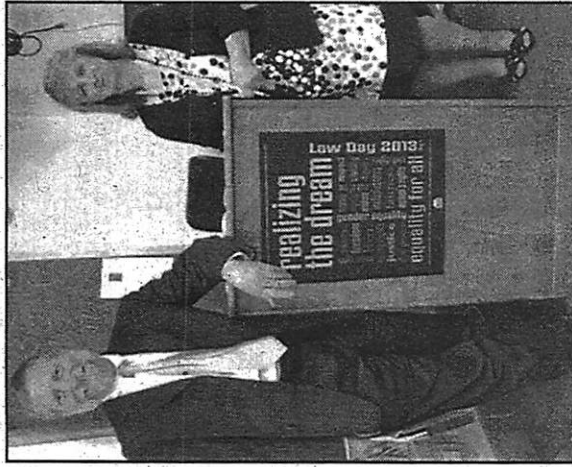
The 2013 competition theme, "Realiz-

This theme is particularly timely as this year marks the 150th anniversary of the Emancipation Proclamation.

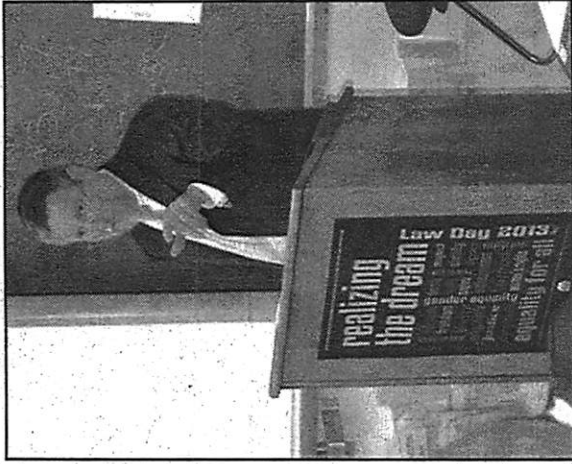
